



## COVID 19 Lawn Bowler and Croquet Player Expectations and Obligations

- 1) Physical Distancing Guidelines
  - You must keep 2 meters/ 6.5 feet apart at all times.
  - Face masks are mandatory except when on the greens
  - Players will be asked a series of questions about their health and recent travel activities before they can check in and play at the club.
- 2) Hand Washing Protocols
  - You will be asked to sanitize your hands when arriving at the club as well as when you leave after play is over.
- 3) Club House Registration
  - You must register with the on-duty Monitor when you arrive.
  - You will be asked a series of questions regarding your health and recent travel activities before you can play.
  - Jacks, mats, mallets and balls will be sanitized prior to play each day and after each scheduled match.
- 4) Kitchen and Club Common Areas
  - These are closed to all club members. City employees will be using the common areas for their daily lunch period (12h00 to 14h00, Monday to Friday). The City will be responsible for sanitizing the areas after the employees have left the Clubhouse.
  - No food or beverages are permitted on Club premises. Water will not be provided by the club so it is recommended that you bring your own water in a recyclable water bottle (no glass please)
- 5) Seating At The Club
  - Chairs and benches will not be available for use at the club. You can bring your own chair.
- 6) Washrooms and Locker Areas
  - Please note: washrooms and locker rooms will not be accessible.
- 7) Bowls
  - You must use your own bowls or rent club bowls at a cost of \$40 for the season. If you rent bowls, you will keep sole possession of them for the season.
  - The free rental of bowls for second year players remains in effect.

#### 8) Croquet Mallets and Balls

- The club mallets and bowls are available for your use and must be sanitized both before and after each use. Wearing gloves when using a club mallet is recommended.

#### 9) Signing-Up for Lawn Bowling and Croquet Play

- You must use the SignupGenius software application to register to play. You will receive an email from The WLBC Team 3 representative (currently Peter Paquet) who will provide you with a URL that you can click on to register your preferred time slot in the SignupGenius application. The URL will look like the following:

- You may also receive a direct email or a text message in lieu of the URL mentioned above.

#### 10) Playing Time

- Playing time for lawn bowling and croquet matches will be presented when you sign on to the SignupGenius application.

#### 11) Designated Waiting Area

- There will be a designated waiting area for players who arrive at the club before their match. You are encouraged to arrive only 10 minutes prior to play.
- No seating will be provided in the designated waiting area.

#### 12) Completion Of Play

- You must leave the club immediately after play.
- No socializing will be allowed on club premises or in the club parking lot.

#### 13) Lawn Bowling Scoreboards and Rakes

- Scoreboards will not be available (you will have to rely on a scorecard). It is recommended to move bowls with your feet once the end played is completed.

#### 14) Cost For The 2020 Season

- The 2020 fees are \$140 per person for all Lawn Bowlers and Croquet players (you can play both with this single fee).
- No new members will be permitted to join the club this 2020 season
